Dear Party City Food / Beverage Vendor,

As you are aware, several states in the US, including Maine, Washington, Vermont, and New York have passed bills that ban the application or inclusion of Per- and polyfluoroalkyl substance (PFAS) chemicals, including PFOA and PFOS in food packaging, with several more states currently working on similar bills.

Your company has been identified as one which provides packaged food products to PCHI. Please reply by August 2nd, 2021 as to what your company is doing in order to:

- a) Meet the evolving PFAS chemical standards, including, but not limited to Maine, New York, Vermont, California, and Washington
- b) Ensure that your items are compliant with future regulations involving food packaging
- c) Communicate PFAS compliance to consumers and or retail customers such as Party City

PCHI and its affiliates continue to expect vendors to adhere to all legal requirements including any applicable PFAS compliance standards and to defend and indemnify PCHI and its affiliates for any claims asserted concerning products supplied by vendor consistent with the PCHI vendor manual and other contract documentation and applicable legal principles.
